



Las Vegas Regional Clean Cities Coalition, Inc. Membership Application & Memorandum of Understanding

The Las Vegas Regional Clean Cities Coalition, Inc. (LVRCCC) was formed in 1993 and designated as the fifth member of the United States Department of Energy's National Clean Cities program. The Clean Cities program was created as a result of The Energy Policy Act of 1992 and it is an umbrella to structure and achieve Energy Policy Act program goals. The program directly supports the Department of Energy's commitment to energy use in the American transportation section that is more efficient, less dependent on foreign sources, less environmentally disruptive, sustainable and safe.

The LVRCCC is an independent 501(c)(3) organization whose primary funding comes from grants, contributions from its Stakeholders, and its volunteer Board of Directors who donate their time to further the efforts of the Coalition. The key to fulfilling our mission is for Stakeholders and Supporters to become champions for the Las Vegas Regional Clean Cities Coalition. By submitting this Membership Application & Memorandum of Understanding, you are committing to helping the LVRCCC achieve its goals and objectives. Commitments are voluntary.

Membership Levels:

Stakeholder

Voting members are referred to as stakeholders. One voting member per company/organization is allowed. Stakeholders regularly attend LVRCCC meetings and events; serve on a LVRCCC committee; purchase AFVs for their fleets; develop and provide AFV training; build, operate or maintain a fueling station; and provide funding and/or grants to the Coalition. Stakeholder companies formally acknowledge their commitment(s) by signing this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). **Annual dues are \$300.** Additional financial contributions are welcome.

Benefits include:

- Company logo in the LVRCCC quarterly newsletter, *Valley Sky-Lines* (1 issue per year)
- Company listing and link on LVRCCC website
- Recognition at LVRCCC meetings and events
- LVRCCC member tagline usage
- Invitation to summer networking event
- One promotional email to LVRCCC database on behalf of Stakeholder's company promoting an upcoming event

Stakeholders must renew their membership annually to receive membership benefits. The membership cycle is January 1 - December 31. The LVRCCC will send a renewal MOU and invoice to each stakeholder in December. The completed MOU and payment are due by January 31 in order to continue receiving Stakeholder benefits. If membership is not renewed then Stakeholder will become an Interested Party. The first year's dues may be pro-rated if a Stakeholder joins after January. Benefits will be adjusted accordingly.

Supporter

A Supporter is any individual from a Stakeholder's company/organization that is not the voting member. The stakeholder's annual dues include membership for an unlimited number of supporters. Each Supporter has the opportunity to attend LVRCCC meetings and events, receive Coalition announcements and the LVRCCC newsletter, and participate in the summer networking event.

Interested Party

An Interested Party is any individual who would like to receive Coalition announcements and the quarterly LVRCCC newsletter. A company listing on the LVRCCC website is included with this level of membership.
